1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To agree the allocation of £20,000 from Great Western Way Section 106 agreement into the capital programme.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 To allocate the £20,000 Section 106 money received from Great Western Way to the capital programme to be spent at Stourport Riverside.

3.0 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 £20,000 was received from the developers in 2006 relating to the land in Great Western Way.
- 3.2 This money was earmarked to be spent on play in Stourport.

4.0 GREAT WESTERN WAY

- 4.1 The nearest play facility to Great Western Way is Stourport Riverside.
- 4.2 The £20,000 is due to be spent on replacing the surface beneath the space net with wet pour and replace the fence surrounding this.

4.3 The space net is well used and for safety and practical reason the replacement surface will be a major step forward.

5.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 The £20,000 Section 106 money would be allocated in the capital programme to Stourport Riverside.
