#### 2006/07 Quarter 3 Summary

Wyre Forest District Council has attracted an additional £1,647,998 to the district for this financial year.

By division this breaks down as follows:

The authority continues to seek external funding to deliver additional services to the residents of Wyre Forest. Current successes include the Envirowise programme encouraging resource efficiency to businesses based on the Stourport Road.

Funding from the Childrens Fund has enabled a further two Rangers to be employed to develop the work of the Rangers in target areas in the district.

The continued success of Stourport Forward, the Market Town Initiative funding that is used to part fund activities that encourage increased investment in the town. This is being utilised in areas such as the Stourport Basins development and the skatepark that is being built later this year. There partnership role is also proving beneficial in Sandy Lane Industrial Estate in Stourport, where a feasibility study has been funded by AWM which will lead to a large scale refurbishment of the road infrastructure on the estate.

The External Funding Group continues to monitor the progress of external funding applications in the district and to report on any difficulties that the group can work to overcome.
