DECRIMINALISATION OF PARKING ENFORCEMENT (DPE) FORMAL RESOLUTIONS	The Cabinet considered a report from the Head of Cultural, Leisure and Commercial Services regarding the Decriminalisation of On-Street Parking Enforcement within the Wyre Forest district.  The Council is recommended:  1. The Council will undertake the Decriminalisation of On-Street Parking in the district boundaries of Wyre Forest, Worcestershire.  2. The Council adopts the Parking Charge Notice level of £60.00 per parking offence, discounted to £30.00 for payments received within 14 days and incremented to £90.00 for payments after the issue of a charge certificate, as reflected in the financial model and consultant report.
