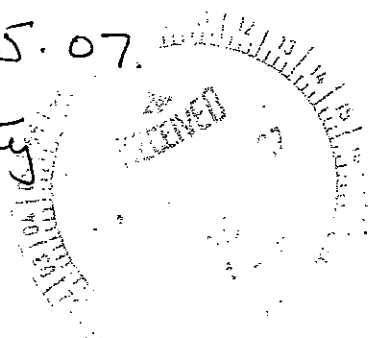

Dear Sir,

Could I please join my voice with others to protest at the changing policy of the taxi service; I used Central Taxis regularly, and hope to continue to do so, but the introduction of the high-style, wheel-chair friendly CABS, are making travelling very difficult. I can neither get into them, nor climb out of them with any comfort at all - and certainly no dignity.

I am confined to using a stick after several leg surgery for bone cancer, but I see no point in aiming to supply the 2% of the population who use a wheel chair, with 100%

access when a huge number of otherwise limited-ability passengers can't get into the cabs at all.

I am sure this is Government Policy but I don't regard that as sacrosanct — or, indeed, any excuse, but please ensure that there is a proportion of vehicles which can be used by all members of the local community.
