1. <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

1.1 For Members to consider the results of the public consultation on the draft Character Appraisal for the Upper Arley Conservation Area and to agree the final document.

2. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

The Cabinet is asked to DECIDE:

2.1 To approve the Upper Arley Conservation Area Character Appraisal.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 A Conservation Area Character Appraisal sets out the special architectural and historic characteristics of a Conservation Area and is intended to provide guidance for planning decisions.
- 3.2 The draft Upper Arley Appraisal, together with background information was considered by Cabinet on 26th July 2007, and approved for public consultation.

4. KEY ISSUES

Method of Public Consultation

- 4.1 A public consultation was undertaken commencing on 7th September 2007 and was closed on 19th October 2007.
- 4.2 The consultation consisted of a small pamphlet being sent to residents and land-owners within the Area, and all amenity groups with an interest in the Area. Copies of the document were sent to Ward Members for the area, the Parish Council and English Heritage.
- 4.3 A display and copy of the Character Appraisal were placed in the foyer of the Worcestershire Hub in Kidderminster Town Hall for the duration of the consultation period. The Character Appraisal was also published on the Council's website, including hyperlinks to email to enable web-responses.
- 4.4 The consultation included a presentation to Upper Arley Parish Council, at a meeting held on the 26th September 2007.

Results of Public Consultation

- 4.5 A total of 2 consultation responses were received and these are outlined in *Appendix 1*. The two respondents were generally supportive of the draft Appraisal.
- 4.6 The results of the public consultation are due to be considered by the Community and Regeneration Scrutiny Committee on 7th November 2007. Any recommendations will be reported to Cabinet.

5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 There are no financial implications arising from the Conservation Area Appraisal.

6. LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS

6.1 The Conservation Area Appraisal and the public consultation have been carried out in accordance with guidance produced by English Heritage in February 2006.
