The Principal Licensing Officer outlined the request which had been received from Mr. R.K. South, Secretary of the Wyre Forest Taxi Drivers' Association that a driver's name should not be required to be displayed on the Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Vehicle Driver's Badge issued by the Council.

Mr. South attended the meeting and addressed the Committee. Mr. South

handed to the Committee a survey which he had carried out with 100 of the taxi drivers licensed within the District. Mr. South informed the Committee that out of 100 drivers asked to complete the survey only 2 had refused, and 98 supported the application that no name should be included in the badge and 69 of the drivers confirmed that no incidents of concern had happened to them as a consequence of their names appearing on the badge. The majority of drivers who had reported problems were night time drivers.

Members were concerned about the survey being handed in on the day and wished to have time to study the survey.
