WYRE FOREST DISTRICT LOCAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK (LDF): CORE STRATEGY REVISED ISSUES AND OPTIONS PAPER

At the meeting of the Prosperity Panel on 4th April 2007 it was agreed that a Review Panel would be established to consider the preparation of the Core Strategy.

On the 13th June 2007 the Committee considered a briefing paper on the Core Strategy Issues and Options Paper for the purposes of public consultation. This consultation took place during summer 2007.

At it's meeting on 9th January 2008 Members heard from the Chairman of the LDF Review Panel who assured the Committee that the Review Panel had thoroughly read and discussed all documents concerning the Core Strategy Revised Issues and Options Paper.

The Committee noted that, in response to comments received from Government Office for the West Midlands, the Revised Paper contained a more comprehensive Spatial Portrait which identified the key issues and challenges facing the District and that the Revised Paper also incorporated a revised Spatial Vision along with twelve revised Spatial Objectives.

RECOMMENDED TO CABINET:

The Revised Issues and Options Paper for the purpose of public consultation, in accordance with Regulation 25 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, be endorsed.
