1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider a request by Bewdley Town Council for payment of their £11,666 Section 136 Grant Aid for 2008/2009.

- 3.1 As part of the annual Budget process, Council on 27th February 2008 approved the sum of £11,666 additional grant to Bewdley Town Council, equivalent to 15% of parish precept.
- 3.2 The grant was to be used for purposes agreed or stipulated and administered through the Cabinet.
- 3.3 A request for payment of the grant aid has now been received and a copy of the request is enclosed for Members' information as Appendix 1.
