1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider nominations for the title of Honorary Alderman in accordance with the procedure adopted by the Council at its meeting on 18th April, 2005.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

The Cabinet is asked to RECOMMEND to Council

2.1 To confer the title of Honorary Alderman on John Clive Simmonds in accordance with Section 249 of the Local Government Act 1972.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 It falls within the Cabinet's terms of reference, under its non-delegated powers, to consider and make a subsequent recommendation to Council, on nominations to the position of Honorary Alderman.
- 3.2 The Cabinet is requested to consider an application by Councillor John Paul Campion nominating John Clive Simmonds to the position of Honorary Alderman of the District.
- 3.3 The Council's Appointment Procedure provides that a person shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration to be nominated to the position of Honorary Alderman if he or she:-
 - (i) has rendered a minimum of 20 years service as a Member of Wyre Forest District Council; and

- (ii) has rendered eminent or notable service to the district by serving as a Chairperson of a major Council Committee or holding one or more senior positions on the Council or in any political group.
- 3.4 A summary of the nominee's record of public service from 1973 is set out in para 4.2 of this report. The nominee has indicated her willingness to accept nomination for the position of an Honorary Alderman.

4. KEY ISSUES

- 4.1 If the Cabinet is so minded to support the nomination, in accordance with the Councils Appointment Procedure, it will be necessary for the Cabinet's recommendation to be submitted for consideration at an Extraordinary meeting of the Council, convened for that purpose.
