1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 For Cabinet to consider the results of the public consultation on the draft Character Appraisal for the Broome Conservation Area and to agree the final document.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 The Broome Conservation Area Character Appraisal be approved.

3.0 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 A Conservation Area Character Appraisal sets out the special architectural and historic characteristics of a Conservation Area and is intended to provide guidance for planning decisions.
- 3.2 The draft Broome Appraisal, together with background information was considered by Cabinet on 24th April 2008, and approved for public consultation.

4. KEY ISSUES

Method of Public Consultation

4.1 A public consultation was undertaken commencing on 2nd May 2008 and was closed on 13th June 2008.

- 4.2 The consultation consisted of a copy small pamphlet and explanatory letter being sent to residents and land-owners within the Area, and all amenity groups with an interest in the Area. Copies of the document were also sent to Ward Members for the area, the Parish Council and English Heritage.
- 4.3 A display and copy of the Character Appraisal were placed in the foyer of the Worcestershire Hub in Kidderminster Town Hall for the duration of the consultation period. The Character Appraisal was also published on the Council's website, including hyperlinks to email to enable web-responses.

Results of Public Consultation

- 4.4 No responses were received to the public consultation including from Broome Parish Council.
- 4.5 The results of the public consultation are due to be considered by the Community and Regeneration Scrutiny Committee on 23rd July 2008. Any recommendations will be reported to Cabinet.
