Appointment of Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Ethics and Standards Committee

1. Purpose of the Report

1.1. To inform the Committee that Council, at its meeting on 26th November 2008, approved the appointment of Rev J A Cox as Chairman and Mrs C A Noons as Vice-Chairman of the Ethics and Standards Committee.

3. Background

- 3.1. At the last meeting of the Ethics and Standards Committee on 29th July 2008 the Chairman of the Ethics and Standards Committee tendered his resignation on ill health grounds.
- 3.2. The appointment of Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen of the authority's committees is a matter for agreement for Council under Standing Order B1 (constitution of Committees) in the Council's Constitution.
- 3.3. The Standards Committee (England) Regulations 2008 requires the Chairman of the Ethics and Standards Committee to be an Independent Member. Wyre Forest District Council also considers it good practice to appoint an independent Member as Vice-Chairman.

5.1. The appointment of Independent Members to the position of Chairman is a requirement under the Standards Committee (England) Regulations 2008.
