1. <u>PURPOSE OF REPORT</u>

1.1 To inform Members of the proposed increases in the fees and charges within the Council's Licensing, Food and Health and Safety and Pollution Control functions for 2009/2010.

2. <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

The Committee is asked to RECOMMEND to Council:

2.1 the proposals for fees and charges within the Council's Licensing, Food and Health and Safety and Pollution Control functions for 2009/2010, as detailed in the report, be included in the 2009/2010 budget strategy.

3. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

- 3.1 The Council's current financial strategy in respect of fees and charges is to increase them in line with inflation or slightly above, with Heads of Service expected to maximise the potential for income generation. The target increase proposed for 2009/2010 is 3.5%.
- 3.2 A review of licensing fees and charges, for the period 2009/2010, reflects no reason to fundamentally alter the fee structure based on full recovery of costs.

4. **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

4.1 It is proposed that fees should be increased by 3.5 per cent (rounded up, where appropriate) and it is estimated that an additional £4,000 will be raised per annum [List at Appendix 1].

5. LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS

5.1 The proposed increase is in line with current policy on fee income.

6. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

6.1 The fees and charges are non-profit making and Cost Centres will reflect the operation of the service.
