## <u>'Connecting' Kidderminster Regeneration Prospectus Adoption Document</u>

Members considered a briefing paper and presentation from the Regeneration and Economic Prosperity Manager detailing ideas generated through consultation with the public and key stakeholders on the development of a Regeneration Prospectus for Kidderminster.
