## 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To update the Council's Data Protection Policy.

#### 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

The Cabinet is asked to RECOMMEND to Council that:

2.1 The revised Data Protection Policy 2009 to 2011 be adopted by the Council and the next review of the policy be carried out in 2011.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Data Protection Act 1998 ("the Act") repealed the 1984 Act and came into force on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2001. It was implemented on a phased basis with full implementation in October 2007.
- 3.2 The Act covers both electronic and manual records. It protects personal data and gives individuals the right of access to data held about them and a level of control over how it is used.
- 3.3 Although the Council has well-established practices to ensure compliance with Data Protection legislation, this policy makes textual amendments to the previous policy which was agreed in 2001. The amendments have been made in the light of experience and in administrating requests for personal data since the implementation of the Act.

- 3.4 This policy outlines how the Council complies with the Act and provides a framework for managing requests.
- 3.5 The policy will be reviewed in 2011 to ensure that it remains relevant and reflects the prevailing information security environment at that time.
