1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To update the Audit Committee on the amount external funding being attracted into the District; and the variety of projects for which said funding is contributing towards for the benefit of the District and its residents.

2. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee is asked to NOTE:

2.1 The amount of External Funding being attracted to the District as attached in *Appendix 1*.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1. Wyre Forest District Council (WFDC) promotes and improves the economic, social, and environmental well being of the district in the best interests and for the greatest benefit of its inhabitants, residents, businesses and visitors.
- 3.2. The District Council is increasingly dependant on attracting external funding sources, in addition to its own budgets, to meet its own priorities as well of those of the community.
- 3.3. In April 2005 the District Council adopted its External Funding Strategy to establish protocol and aid development to all stakeholders and partner organisations that WFDC work with (on external funded projects) to be aware of their roles and responsibilities.
- 3.4. A review of this Strategy was completed in April 2009 in order to ensure that it is meeting its aims and objectives effectively, and that the protocol is relevant and up to date. As a result of this review the Strategy was renamed the 'External Funding Monitoring Policy' to emphasize its primary role as a monitoring exercise.

External funding bid information is obtained and recorded on a quarterly basis to ensure that funding is reported and monitored regularly. This is reported in the form of position statements and is supplied to Cabinet, CMT and the Members Information Bulletin. The Audit Committee is also to receive an annual position statement at the end of the financial year detailing funding information for the whole year.

4. KEY ISSUES

- 4.1 Appendix 1 is the External Funding report for Quarter 1, April June 2009. However, the information includes bids submitted up to 17th June and therefore there could potentially be more bids made towards the end of the month that will be reported in the next update.
- 4.2 These reports will continue to be updated on a quarterly basis to monitor funding at the District Council are directly and indirectly involved with accruing for the benefit of the District.

5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 There is a financial implication section covered in the External Funding Monitoring Policy along with a VAT/Council body framework that gives an overview of the questions the Council should be addressing before accepting accountability for any funding delivery.

6. <u>LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS</u>

6.1 As part of the External Funding Monitoring Policy, officers are asked to seek advice from the Legal and Democratic Services Division on individual projects before entering the Authority into any external funding agreements.
