- 3.1 At the meeting of Full Council on 24th February 2010, the Council approved the Regulatory Services shared service and inter alia delegated authority for the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Leader and Corporate Management Team, to finalise the legal agreement for the shared service, including the statement of service requirements, in an information report to Cabinet on the service requirements.
- 3.2 Cabinet had previously agreed the principle of the WETT shared services at their meeting on 19th January 2010.

4.1 Partners' service requirements are appended to this report. The service requirements template records those requirements that are applicable to all partners and those that are applicable only to the individual Councils.

- 4.2 Each Council has taken the lead on a specific service area (Wyre Forest is leading on infectious diseases) which addresses the requirements applicable to all partners and then each partner has added their own individual requirements under that specific service area.
- 4.3 This exercise is being co-ordinated across all of the partners by the Regulatory Services Project Implementation Team (PIT) and will be signed off by the Regulatory Services Project Board in time for the signing of the legal agreements on 1st June 2010.
