<u>DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – GUIDANCE NOTE</u>

<u>Code of Conduct</u> – Members are reminded that under the Code of Conduct it is the responsibility of individual Members to declare any personal or personal and prejudicial interest in any item on this agenda. A Member who declares a personal interest may take part in the meeting and vote, unless the interest is also prejudicial. If the interest is prejudicial, as defined in the Code, the Member must leave the room. However, Members with a prejudicial interest can still participate if a prescribed exception applies or a dispensation has been granted.

<u>Section 106 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992</u> – If any Member is two months or more in arrears with a Council Tax payment, they may not vote on any matter which might affect the calculation of the Council Tax, any limitation of it, its administration or related penalties or enforcement.

(A) TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE COUNCIL

The Council

- 1. Is the ultimate decision making Body.
- 2. Determines the political Management Structure and any subsequent amendments to it.
- 3. Determines the Budget (but reserves powers to itself in relation to requirements).
- 4. Is responsible for appointing (and dismissing) the Leader of the Council, the Deputy Leader of the Council and other Members of the Cabinet.
- 5. Appoints at its Annual Meeting, the Regulatory Committees, the Overview and Scrutiny Committees and any other Committees/Forums necessary to conduct the Council's business.
- 6. Decides on matters where the Cabinet is not minded to determine a matter in accordance with Council policy.

(B) MATTERS RESERVED TO THE COUNCIL

- 1. Those reserved by Law e.g. levying a rate, borrowing money, promotion of or opposition to a Bill in Parliament.
- 2. Matters reserved to the Council by financial regulations.
- 3. The adoption and amendment of Standing Orders, including the powers and duties of Committees and other forums.
- 4. The making of any By-Laws, Rules or other regulations requiring the approval of the Secretary of State or a Minister of the Crown.
- 5. The determination of the objectives of the Council.
- 6. Matters of new policy or variation of existing policy and the allocation of resources.
- 7. Local Development Framework adoption.
- 8. Any function where a decision would be contrary to a plan, policy, budget or strategy previously adopted by the Council, which would be contrary to the Council's Standing Orders, Financial Regulations or Executive arrangements.
- 9. The Scheme of Delegations to Officers.
- 10. Electoral arrangements local authority boundaries including the naming of parishes.
