#### LIC.40 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors A J Buckley and P V Hayward.

#### LIC.41 Appointment of Substitutes

Councillor G C Yarranton was a substitute for Councillor A Buckley.

#### LIC.42 Declaration of Interests

No declarations of interest were made.

#### LIC.43 Minutes

Decision: The minutes of the meeting held on 14th September 2011 be confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

Before the meeting commenced the Solicitor advised Members that the Committee would inspect each taxi in turn and reminded Members that matters should not be discussed whilst outside either with each other or the taxi drivers. Members were also asked to take a consistent approach with the previous applications that had been considered.

# LIC.44 Application to Renew a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence Beyond the Council's adopted Policy of Age Criteria (1997)

A report was considered from the Director of Worcestershire Regulatory Services on behalf of Wyre Forest District Council that asked the Committee to consider an application for the renewal of a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence made by Mr R. Dyer, 4 Forester Way, Kidderminster, Worcestershire DY10 1NT, as it fell outside of the Age Criteria Policy set by the Council in 1997.

The Licensing Officer informed Members that the applications to renew the

Hackney Carriage Proprietor Licences that were being presented to the Committee fell outside of the Policy adopted by the Council and that they were being asked to assess whether or not the vehicles presented could be an exception to the Policy on the grounds of quality safety and accessibility, mileage and the protection of the travelling public. The Committee were reminded that their decision was to be based on the prime aim of the Council, which was to make travelling in Wyre Forest as safe as possible. He also reminded Members that the Council had a duty to protect the travelling public. All of the taxis before the Committee had been inspected by Licensing Officers and it was felt that none of them were exceptional to the Council's policy. He advised Members that they would have to make a decision as to whether or not they should depart from the policy set in 1997.

The Licensing Officer led Members through the report relating to vehicle registration number GN52 VXK.

Mr Dyer and Mr Owen had no comments to make in support of their applications.

Members of the Committee left the Council Chamber to inspect the vehicles, registration numbers GN52 VXK and YK52 WDG at this point, (10.41am) and returned at 10.46am.

Members of the Committee, the Solicitor and Democratic Services Officer stayed in the meeting to deliberate their decision and Mr Owen, Mr Dyer, Mr Baras, Ms Williams and the Licensing Officers left the meeting whilst the Committee reached their decision.

Decision: Having carefully considered the application to grant a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence in respect of vehicle registration number GN52 VXK, the Committee decided that subject to the following works being carried out to the satisfaction of the Licensing Officer within 14 days of this meeting:

- 1. the front bumper to be repaired/replaced (as appropriate);
- 2. the scratch on the rear side quarter panel to be repaired;
- 3. the drivers door to be repaired; and
- 4. the steering wheel cover to be replaced,

that a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence HC 039 vehicle registration number GN52 VXK be granted for twelve months from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2012 because, otherwise, on inspection of the vehicle the Committee found, in considering quality, safety and accessibility, that the vehicle was for the age of the vehicle presented in an exceptional condition: where the body work was good and that the interior is exceptional and clean, which gave the Committee grounds to depart from the Age Criteria Policy in relation to this application.

# LIC.45 Application to Renew a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence Beyond the Council's adopted Policy of Age Criteria (1997)

A report was considered from the Director of Worcestershire Regulatory Services on behalf of Wyre Forest District Council that asked the Committee to consider an application for the renewal of a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence made by Robert Edward Ingle of Regency Vehicle Hire, 5 Comberton Terrace, Kidderminster, as it fell outside of the Age Criteria Policy set by the Council in 1997.

The Licensing Officer led Members through the report relating to vehicle registration number YK52 WDG.

Mr Owen had been appointed to speak on behalf of Mr Ingle and he had no comments to make in relation to the application.

Members of the Committee, the Solicitor and Democratic Services Officer stayed in the meeting to deliberate their decision and Mr Owen, Mr Baras, Ms Williams and the Licensing Officers left the meeting whilst the Committee reached their decision.

Decision: Having carefully considered the application to grant a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence in respect of vehicle registration number YK52 WDG, the Committee decided that a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's Licence HC030 vehicle registration number YK52 WDG be granted for twelve months from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2012 because on inspection of the vehicle the Committee found, in considering quality, safety and accessibility, that the vehicle was for the age of the vehicle presented in an exceptional condition: where the body work was good and that the interior was exceptional and clean, which gave the Committee grounds to depart from the Age Criteria Policy in relation to this application.

Decision: Having carefully considered the application to grant a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence to Mr Nadeem Salem Baras, the Committee has decided that the application to grant a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence to Mr Nadeem Salem Baras be refused on the grounds that the applicant did not appear to the Committee to be "a fit and proper person" to hold such a Licence.

#### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To inform Members of the proposed increases in the fees and charges in respect of the Council's Regulatory Service Function for 2012/2013.

#### 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

The Committee is asked to RECOMMEND to Council:

2.1 That the proposals for fees and charges within the Council's Licensing, Food, Health, Safety and Pollution Control functions for 2012/2013, as detailed in the report, be included in the 2012/2013 budget strategy.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

3.1 The Council's current financial strategy in respect of fees and charges is to increase them in line with inflation or slightly above, with Heads of Service expected to maximise the potential for income generation. The target increase proposed for 2012/2013 is 5%.

#### 4. KEY ISSUES

4.1 A review of licensing fees and charges, for the period 2012/2013, dictates a fee structure based on full recovery of costs.

#### 5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 It is proposed that fees should be increased by 5 per cent rounded up, where appropriate (*see Appendix 1 attached*).
- 5.2 The budget forecast details the cost versus income for licensing as follows: the costs are based on 2011/2012 as no detailed figures are available for the coming

year, but overall costs for regulatory services have risen for 2012/13 (accountancy information) and so there is confidence in using this figure.

#### 6. **LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

6.1 The agreed income to be generated by the proposed licence fees and charges is in line with the current policy and the council is not projected to make any profit on the licensing account for the forthcoming year.

#### 7. RISK MANAGEMENT

7.1 There is a risk that the Councils Regulatory Services Licensing fees and charges could be challenged. To minimise this risk the fees and charges must be designed to meet but not exceed, the cost the Council reasonably believes will be incurred in issuing of licences and the administration of the service.

#### 8. EQUALITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT

8.1 There are no equality impact assessment issues arising from this report.

#### 9. **CONCLUSION**

9.1 The fees and charges are non-profit making and Cost Centres will reflect the operation of the service.

- 3.3 On 13 December 2011 the Licensing Office received a letter from the newly formed Bewdley Taxi Association, formally requesting a review of the current taxi tariff, putting forward three proposals. Attached to

- the request was a petition signed by 21 licensed hackney carriage drivers also in support of a fare increase.
- 3.4 A copy of the Bewdley Taxi Associations fare increase request and the signed petition is attached at "appendix 1"

#### 4. KEY ISSUES

4.1 The current Wyre Forest Taxi Fare Tariff has been in place since 21<sup>st</sup> May 2008.

#### 5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 There will be a cost to undertake the consultation, which will include both administration and postage.

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#### **FUEL PRICE REPORT MAY 2008**

In the past month, diesel prices have risen by their highest margin this century and are now almost 12 pence per fittre more expensive than petrol. High oil prices, breaking through the \$125 mark, have also fuelled a near-record rise in petrol prices.

Nationally, unleaded prices have risen by 4.5ppl to 112.6ppl in the past month. Diesel prices have risen by 6.8ppl to 124.2ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has risen from 9.3ppl to 11.6ppl.

London recorded the highest price for unleaded at 113.3ppl followed by the South East at 113.1ppl. Yorkshire and Humberside again recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 111.6ppl. Wales recorded the highest diesel price at 124.7ppl. Yorkshire and Humberside still have the cheapest diesel at 123.4ppl.

Supermarket prices for unleaded also rose over the month by 3.9ppl to 110.7ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for unleaded has increased to 1.9ppl.

Overseas prices have risen. The UK has the ninth highest unleaded price in Europe and the second highest diesel price.
