**Report in relation to the release of funding earmarked for Civic Centre,
Stourport-on-Severn**

1. **PURPOSE**

up to 95%

To request the release of £25,000 for a feasibility study into the transfer of The Civic Centre and Civic Hall, Stourport-on-Severn project to Stourport Town Council, ahead of the proposed freehold transfer of the whole building to the Town Council.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

To release £25,000 of the monies earmarked for The Civic Centre and Civic Hall, Stourport-on-Severn project to Stourport Town Council for them to carry out a feasibility report.

3. **BACKGROUND**

In October 2011 Council agreed to make available £500,000 towards the transfer of The Civic Centre and Civic Hall, Stourport-on-Severn.

up to 90%
Stourport Town Council now require £25,000 to carry out a feasibility study into the viability of transferring The Civic Centre and Civic Hall, Stourport-on-Severn to Stourport Town Council.

4. **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

This amount is within the earmarked project budget.

5. **LEGAL IMPLICATIONS**

The proposed transfer to Stourport Town Council would be a permitted transfer at an under value pursuant to regulations.
