Information which is subject to any obligation of confidentiality.

Information which relates in any way to matters concerning national security.

Declaration of Interests by Members – interests of members in contracts and other matters

Declarations of Interest are a standard item on every Council and Committee agenda and each Member must provide a full record of their interests in the Public Register.

In addition, alongside the Register of Interest, the Members Code of Conduct ("the Code") requires the Declaration of Interests at meetings. Members have to decide first whether or not they have a disclosable interest in the matter under discussion.

Please see the Members' Code of Conduct as set out in Section 14 of this constitution for full details.

Disclosable Pecuniary Interest (DPI) / Other Disclosable Interest (ODI)

DPI's and ODI's are interests defined in the Code of Conduct that has been adopted by the District.

If you have a DPI (as defined in the Code) in a matter being considered at a meeting of the Council (as defined in the Code), the Council's Standing Orders require you to leave the room where the meeting is held, for the duration of any discussion or voting on that matter.

If you have an ODI (as defined in the Code) you will need to consider whether you need to leave the room during the consideration of the matter.

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors P Dyke and J Greener.

LIC.9 Minutes

Decision: The minutes of the meeting held on 17th June 2013 be confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

LIC.10 Hackney Carriage Fare Increase Request

The Committee received a report from the Director of Worcestershire Regulatory Services (WRS) on behalf of Wyre Forest District Council to consider a request for an increase to the current Wyre Forest Hackney Carriage Fare Tariff, following a 4 week consultation with the Wyre Forest Taxi Trade.

The Senior Licensing Practitioner (WRS) led Members through the report and advised that additional information; including a comparison of taxi fares in Worcestershire, the national average fare table for June 2013 and fuel price reports, had been circulated to Members prior to the Meeting to assist them in their decision making process.

In response to a Members question regarding the re-issuing of the agenda, the Senior Licensing Practitioner confirmed the report had been amended to include additional information relating to the consultation responses and provide a firmer recommendation for Members to consider.

The Committee were addressed by Mr Alton, Chairman of Bewdley Taxi

Association who asked Members to support the fare increase request, and Mr

Owen who reiterated the points made in his consultation response.

Members discussed the various fare increase options listed in the report and also considered an increase in line with inflation. The Committee agreed there should be no increase to the tariff at the present time, however the issue should be discussed at the next meeting of the Wyre Forest Taxi Liaison Group which is made up of taxi trade representatives from across the whole of the District. Members felt this was the forum where any requests for fare rises should be initiated from.

Agreed:

- There is no increase to the current Hackney Carriage Fare Tariff at the present time.
- Councillor M B Kelly be appointed as the Council's representative on the Wyre Forest Taxi Liaison Group.

There being no further business, the meeting ended at 11.10am.
