The Committee received a report from the Director of Worcestershire Regulatory Services (WRS) on behalf of Wyre Forest District Council which

informed Members of the increase in the fees and charges in respect of the Council's Regulatory Service Function for 2014/2015.

The Senior Licensing Practitioner (WRS) led Members through the report and advised that the Medium Term Financial Strategy 2014-2017 had been agreed at the meeting of the Full Council on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2013. Therefore, the report was for information only.

Councillor J Greener entered the meeting at this point, (10.36am).

# LIC.23 Application for the Grant of a Hackney Carriage Private Hire Driver's Licence

The Committee received a report from the Director of WRS on behalf of Wyre Forest District Council that asked Members to consider an application for the grant of a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence.

Prior to presenting the report the Senior Licensing Practitioner (WRS) advised Members that the first and third convictions listed at paragraph 5.2 on page 27 of the exempt report to the Committee, were both dealt with by way of a conditional discharge. They were not classed as convictions in the Council's "Guidance relating to the Relevance of Convictions", and therefore should not be considered when determining the application.

The Senior Licensing Practitioner led Members through the report and highlighted the relevant convictions listed on the DBS disclosure form.

The applicant addressed the Committee and asked Members to support his application.

The Senior Licensing Practitioner and applicant left the meeting at this point, (11.26am), for Members to deliberate their decision. The Solicitor and the Committee and Member Services Officer stayed in the meeting whilst the Committee reached their decision.

#### **Decision:**

Having carefully considered the application to grant a Hackney

Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence to the applicant, the Committee has decided that the application to grant a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Driver's Licence to the applicant be refused on the grounds that the applicant did not appear to the Committee, with due consideration of the Council's "Guidelines relating to the Relevance of Convictions", to be "a fit and proper person" to hold such a Licence in light of:

- 1. the applicant having being convicted on more than one occasion for various offences over a number of years he has shown a pattern for committing criminal offences; and
- 2. the convictions listed under PNC ID(1) Conviction 4 and 5, PNC ID(2) of the Disclosure & Barring Service Enhanced Certificate and the current SP30 show a significant history of driving offences; and
- 3. the applicant has been convicted of driving without insurance on more than one occasion; and
- 4. the applicant has not demonstrated five years free from driving convictions since having his licence restored following disqualification from driving for a major traffic offence and so, in accordance with the Guidelines, this application should be refused.

There being no further business, the meeting ended at 11.46am.

#### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider a request from the Wyre Forest Taxi Drivers Association for an increase to the current Wyre Forest Hackney Carriage Fare Tariff.

#### 2. RECOMMENDATION

The Committee is asked to consider:

Increasing the current Wyre Forest Hackney Carriage Fare Tariff in line with the proposal put forward by the Wyre Forest Taxi Drivers Association as follows:

• Increase the initial flag fare from £2.70 to £3.00 for  $1^{st} \frac{1}{2}$  mile

#### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 On the 5<sup>th</sup> December 2013 at a meeting of the Wyre Forest Taxi Liaison Group members discussed a proposal put forward by Mr Robert South, Secretary and Treasurer of the Wyre Forest Taxi Drivers Association that there should be an increase to the current Wyre Forest hackney carriage fare tariff.
- 3.2 During the meeting various options were discussed and it was agreed by the chairman that Mr South could Ballot Wyre Forest's licensed drivers in order to determine whether there was support from the trade for an increase and to establish a preferred option. It was further agreed that the Licensing Office would assistance Mr South with the ballot by way of

- notifying all drivers. Members will note that the procedure of balloting drivers by the Association is different to how previous request have been dealt with by Wyre Forest District Council.
- 3.3 On the 7<sup>th</sup> February 2014 following the driver ballot a formal request was then received by the Licensing Office from Mr South on behalf of the Wyre Forest Taxi Drivers Association, requesting an increase to the current hackney carriage fare tariff. The letter gave details of the preferred increase option, an indication of responses received in relation to the ballot and a list or reasons why an increase is considered by them to be necessary at this time, these being:
  - Increase in payments to the Council in order to operate
  - Fuel costs
  - Insurance for vehicles still increasing
  - Maintenance for vehicles still increasing
- 3.4 A copy of the letter submitted by Mr South on behalf of the Wyre Forest Taxi Drivers Association requesting an increase to the current Wyre Forest Hackney Carriage Fare Tariff is attached at "Appendix 1"

#### 4. KEY ISSUES

- 4.1 One option has been put forward by the Wyre Forest taxi trade for consideration by the Committee members. Details of the proposed option is attached at "Appendix 2"
- 4.2 Consultation has taken place with the taxi trade to establish the preferred increase option and should members be minded to approve the increase, public consultation will take place as detailed at 6.2 of this report. Consultation is undertaken as there is a need for Members to balance the needs of the trade and the affordability of the service to it's users.
- 4.3 The current Wyre Forest Taxi Fare Tariff has been in place since 1 June 2012. A copy of the current Fare Tariff is attached at "**Appendix 3**"
- 4.4 The proposal put forward represents an 11% increase on the current flag fare charged. This reduces to a 6% increase on an equivalent 2 mile journey and a 3% increase on an equivalent 5 mile journey.
- 4.5 To assist member in making a decision the published National Table of Fares is attached to this report at "Appendix 4" and a comparison of the fares charged within Worcestershire is attached at "Appendix 5"

#### 5. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1 Should an increase be agreed by Committee members, there is then a requirement to display a public notice detailing the increase in the local

press. There will be a cost to advertise the new table of fares and to issue the new fare tariff card to all of the hackney carriage proprietors.

### 6. <u>LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS</u>

- 6.1 Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 gives the local authority the powers to set fares for Hackney Carriages.
- 6.2 If the Committee is minded to grant an increase to the current Hackney Carriage Fare Tariff, any change in fares agreed by the Council must be advertised publicly by way of a press notice for a period of 14 days stating the implementation date giving members of the public the opportunity to object to any proposed increase or variation.
- 6.3 If no objections to the new table of fares are received by the Council, then it is planned that the new tariff will come into effect on the 1 June 2014.
- 6.4 If objections are received, the council shall set a further date, not less than two months after the first specified date, on which the table of fares shall come into force, with or without modification, having taken into account such objections.
