Public Consultation Exercise for the Local Heritage List for the Parish of Chaddesley Corbett

1. PURPOSE

1.1 To seek approval for a public consultation exercise in order to consider the draft Local Heritage List for the Parish of Chaddesley Corbett.

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

- 2.1 That delegated authority be given to the Director of Economic Prosperity and Place to conduct a six week public consultation exercise commencing on 22nd February to consider the Draft Local Heritage List for the Parish of Chaddesley Corbett.
- 2.2 That any consultation responses received are subsequently reported to Planning Committee alongside any resulting proposed amendments to the Local Heritage List for Chaddesley Corbett.

3. **BACKGROUND**

3.1 Local Heritage Lists

The Local Heritage List plays an important role in celebrating heritage that is valued by the community at the local level.

- 3.2 The process of preparing a Local Heritage List allows local people to identify local heritage that they would like recognised and protected. It is also an opportunity for local authorities and communities to work in partnership to jointly identify heritage assets that are valued as distinctive elements of the local historic environment. Creating a Local Heritage List also helps to improve access to clear, comprehensive and current information about the historic environment at the local level through resources such as Heritage Environment Records (HERs).
- 3.3 A Local Heritage List provides clarity on the location of assets and what it is about them that is significant, guaranteeing that strategic local planning properly takes account of the desirability of their conservation.
- 3.4 It is important to note that the Local Heritage List is a non-statutory list.

Policy Background

- 3.5 The National Planning Policy Framework published on 27th March 2012 at Section 12 sets out the Government's agenda for Conserving and enhancing the historic environment.
- 3.6 The NPPF states (at para. 126) that Local planning authorities should recognise that heritage assets are an irreplaceable resource and conserve them in a manner appropriate to their significance.
- 3.7 The NPPF (at para. 128) states that in determining applications [for development], local planning authorities should require an applicant to describe the significance of any heritage assets affected, including any contribution made by their setting.
- 3.8 This means that a local authority may recognise certain heritage assets as having heritage significance meriting consideration in planning matters. So for example where planning permission is being considered, the fact that a heritage asset appears on the Local Heritage List is a valid consideration when determining the outcome of that application.
- 3.9 The adopted Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan 2006-2026 at section 7.48 explains that the Local Heritage List is being produced on a phased basis and that it is envisaged that the list will continue to be updated in the remainder of the rural areas over the next few years.
- 3.10 The Chaddesley Corbett Neighbourhood Plan Adopted 2014 at Policy LLCC15 covers the Local Heritage List. Action 15 of The Plan states that "The Parish Council will work with the local history group and the District Council to gain recognition for places, areas and buildings of significant historic interest by formulating a Local Heritage List."

3.11 The Consultation Process

There are three options:

a) District Council-led Consultation

When lists have been compiled previously, the District Council has undertaken a public consultation process.

This has cost implications for the District as the list is advertised in the press, copies are made available to public libraries and the owners and occupiers of properties identified on the draft list are written to individually. All responses are collated by the District and following meeting(s) with the Parish Council and other interested groups to discuss criteria, the final list is arrived at.

3.12 The consultation period will be 6 weeks commencing Monday 22nd February 2016 with all comments to be received by Monday 4th April 2016.A letter and information leaflet will be sent to the owner/occupier at all addresses

appearing on the draft local heritage list informing them of the proposed list, the proposed inclusion of the property on it and inviting their comments.

The following will also be consulted: Chaddesley Corbett Parish Council; District and County Councillors; Worcestershire Archaeological Unit and HER; Worcestershire Highways.

- 3.13 The consultation will be advertised in the local press and on the Wyre Forest District Council Website.
- 3.14 It is anticipated that the results of the Consultation will be reported to the July 2016 Planning Committee.

b) Parish Council-led Consultation

Action 15 has given the Parish Council a mandate to formulate a list in collaboration with the District Council. The District Council could, in theory, provide the draft list to the Parish and request that it carries out its own consultation exercise and reports the results back to the District.

The drawback to this route is that, ultimately, the list is administered by and is the responsibility of the District not the Parish.

c) No Public Consultation

As a non-statutory list there is legally no requirement to consult on the list.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 Arrangements for a public consultation on the draft Local Heritage List for Chaddesley Corbett can be undertaken within existing agreed budgets.

What is the difference between "Listed Buildings" and buildings included on the Local Heritage List?

Statutorily Listed Buildings are designated by the Government, on the advice of English Heritage. They are graded according to their special architectural or historic significance and are protected by law. Listed Building Consent must be sought prior to undertaking most works. There are policies within the Adopted Local Plan relating directly to Listed Buildings.

Buildings included on the Local Heritage List have a local significance recognised by the District Council. There is no grading system. They are not given any specific protection through law, but the Adopted Local Plan does contain policies to help safeguard these buildings. No special permission is required when undertaking works, unless planning permission is required, as with any other unlisted property. The former terms Locally Listed Building and Local List are now replaced by the terms Heritage Asset and Local Heritage List.

Repairs

Local Heritage Assets are not protected in the same way as Nationally Designated Heritage Assets and thus special permission is not needed for repairs. The District Council does however encourage the use of appropriate materials and design. The general rule of thumb is that any repairs should be undertaken on a like-for-like basis.

Alterations and Extensions

The inclusion of a building on the Local Heritage List does not affect its Permitted Development Rights. Planning permission only has to be sought in the same circumstances as it would be for a building that is not on that list (a separate leaflet explains about permitted development rights). If an extension is proposed, and requires planning permission, then the design of this will be examined during the planning process, to ensure—sympathetic and appropriate design is secured, to protect the character and appearance of the building.

What is a Local Heritage List?

Local heritage listing is a means for a community and a local authority to jointly identify heritage assets that are valued as distinctive elements of the local historic environment. The Local Heritage List identifies those heritage assets that are not protected by statutory designations. A Local Heritage List provides clarity on the location of these assets and what it is about them that is significant. Their local interest could be related to the social and economic history of the area, individuals of local importance, settlement patterns or the age, design and style of buildings.

What is a heritage asset?

A heritage asset can be any building, monument, site, place, area or landscape which is a valued component of the historic environment. It may be designated and have statutory protection or it may be included on a Local Heritage List.

Why include a building on the Local Heritage List?

Britain has had a very diverse building history, with each region having different styles and materials, many of which altered dramatically over time. Local Heritage Listing recognises the buildings within Wyre Forest District that help form its character and history and which are not protected by Statutory Designation. In identifying these buildings, the District Council can encourage sympathetic and appropriate design for extensions, and for any other work that would require planning permission, to ensure that the character and appearance of the best examples of the various styles and types of buildings are retained, both for our enjoyment and education, and for the future.

Heritage assets: not just buildings!

The Local Heritage List is not restricted to buildings. It may comprise sites, places or areas such as village greens or ponds. It may include structures such as bridges and sluices, and historic street furniture such as letterboxes, signposts or telephone boxes.

How can I have my views considered on the Draft Local Heritage List for the Parish of Chaddesley Corbett?

If your property is proposed to be included on the Local Heritage List we would like to hear from you and how you feel about your property being identified as one of local interest and importance. If you would like to express your views, whether through support or concern, please contact us.

Whilst your views and concerns will be considered, Wyre Forest District Council reserves the right to exclude or include heritage assets from the final Local Heritage List.

In addition if there are any further hertiage assets that you consider to be of local significance we we would like to hear from you.
