Reason for the decision/alternatives considered	10 Raven Street is an empty former residential property that the Council acquired as part of a wider area of land running from New Street to Cooper's Lane. The property has been vacant for some time and is falling into disrepair. The Council has considered whether the property would be suitable for investing in with a view to letting but the works required make that an unviable option. The property is beginning to impact on the attached neighbour by way of rising damp so a swift disposal is preferred so that the matter can be dealt with by the new owner.
