1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To approve the entering into a contract for the supply of electricity with the Yorkshire Purchasing Organisation (YPO)

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

The Cabinet is asked to DECIDE:

2.1 To authorise the entering into a contract with NPower for the provision of electricity using the Yorkshire Purchasing Organisation (YPO) Framework for the period 1 April 2019 – 31 March 2023.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Council's current purchasing agent for electricity is the Yorkshire Purchasing Organisation (YPO) with NPower as supplier.
- 3.2 The current contract for electricity supply expires in March 2019. To take advantage of the new YPO framework the Council is required to sign up to an agreement with Npower by 31st January 2019.
- 3.3 YPO carried out a competitive tender between 6 electricity supply companies, EDF, Haven, SSE, Engie, NPower and Total Gas & Power, see results below:

4 KEY ISSUES

- 4.1 Due to the expiry of the contract for the supply of electricity it is essential that the Council progress the new contract for the supply of electricity. The YPO Framework Agreement (with NPower as supplier) offers competitive rates.
- 4.2 The framework has followed EU procurement regulations and was subject to the full EU procurement process.
- 4.3 The new electricity contact will cover the period 1 April 2019 31 March 2023. This enables the Council to procure its supply at the most competitive rate without the need to directly run a procurement process.

5 RECOMMENDATION

5.1 It is recommended that the Council enters into a new contract with NPower for the supply of electricity, commencing 1 April 2019, using the existing framework from YPO for the period up to March 2023.

6 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1 The budget for electricity for 2019/20 is £171,900 per annum, on all sites. The total value of the contract will therefore be within the region of £687,600.

7 LEGAL AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- **7.1** The Contract Procedure Rules require Cabinet approval to enter into contracts where the estimated value of the contract exceeds £160,000.
- 7.2 The Contract Procedure Rules permit the use of framework agreements where the Procurement Officer and the Solicitor to the Council are satisfied that the Council can lawfully use them and that it is in the Council's interest to do so.
- 7.3 The terms and conditions have been reviewed by the Contracts Solicitor.

8 RISK MANAGEMENT

8.1 Failure to continue with the existing framework contract for the supply of electricity would mean that the Council are left without an electricity provider.

9 **EQUALITY IMPACT ASSESSMENT**

9.1 This is a financial report and there is no requirement to consider an Equality Impact Assessment.

10 CONCLUSION

10.1 Approval is sought to use the YPO Framework to enter into a contract for the supply of electricity with NPower and to authorise the entering into a contract under the YPO framework for electricity supply.
