Reason for the decision/alternatives considered	Delegated authority has been given to the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Culture, Leisure and Community Protection, to commence a consultation period on the PSPO, subject to the findings of the evidence-gathering exercise demonstrating to his satisfaction that it is appropriate and proportionate to make a further PSPO.
	Information considered included the findings from the PSPO Review undertaken by the Partnership Analyst within West Mercia Police. The review recommends that the PSPO is renewed to ensure alcohol-related anti-social behaviour remains low after the effects of COVID19.
	There is sufficient evidence to demonstrate that it is proportionate to consider making a further PSPO, and that support for it now needs to be tested in the consultation. It will fall to Cabinet to decide whether or not to proceed with a PSPO following the consultation.
