

DECISION OF LICENSING SUB- COMMITTEE

held on 8 December 2023

Having carefully considered the application to grant premises licence in respect of Asda Express PFS Stourport, Vale Road, Stourport on Severn, DY13 8YJ (“ASDA”) the Licensing Sub-Committee has decided to grant the application in respect of ASDA subject to the following condition proposed by the applicant during the hearing to promote the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance:

“Late night refreshments to be limited to hot drinks only”.

And the reasons for the Sub-Committee’s decision are as follows:

1. The close proximity of a number of residential properties to the premises and the impact, raised in representations, on the amenity of the people who are living in the area surrounding the premises means there is a strong possibility one of the four statutory licensing objectives will be compromised; namely the prevention of public nuisance.
2. The condition offered to the Sub-Committee by the Applicant during the hearing was considered appropriate to address the concerns raised in the representations and has been duly adopted.
3. In coming to this decision, the Sub-Committee has specifically considered the requirements of:
 - a. paragraphs 6.24, 6.25, 6.26, 6.27, 6.28 and 6.29 of the Council’s Licensing Policy; and
 - b. paragraphs 8.2, 8.3 and 8.5 of the Council’s Licensing Policy; and
 - c. paragraphs 2.20 to 2.26 of the section 182 Guidance (August 2023).

- d. Paragraph 2.1 of the section 182 Guidance (August 2023).
- e. paragraphs 6.13 and 6.16, 6.17 of the Council's Licensing Policy; and
- f. paragraph 10.15 of the section 182 Guidance (August 2023)
